

# Community Grief Ceremony

Saturday, December 10<sup>th</sup> 1-5pm, Followed by a Pot-luck dinner.

We are in extraordinary times. For many of us the implications of this election outcome has raised deep and conflicting emotions: Anger, Fear, Grief, Helplessness...and many more. We are witnessing a level of overt hate, viscerally expressed, that has not been seen on this scale ever in our lifetimes.

As light-workers, we feel overwhelmed...

We do not have easy times ahead...and we will need to keep strong and stay in a place of Love and integrity as *Way-Showers* to the World...We cannot collapse into the hatred of the "Other".

We have a small window of time ahead of us before many big changes may commence. During this precious time we need *Guerrilla Self-Care*-- This means fiercely nurturing and tending to our softest, most vulnerable parts; Crying, Feeling our grief, Holding loved ones who share our values, Purging from our systems some of the Shock that has hit our Core, and rattled our Foundation. If we don't tend to ourselves in this way first, we will have a much harder time staying in *Compassionate Neutrality* and being the *Spiritual Warriors* we need to be for the coming times.

This awareness has compelled me to organize a *Community Grief Ceremony*. This ceremony creates a safe container for us to release our grief without judgement. To be held in love and compassion and to lighten some of the heaviness many of us are feeling inside.

You do not need to have shamanic journeying experience to participate. This ceremony will be open to all who wish to come. However, I do not recommend bringing children due to the intense nature of the ceremony.

**LOCATION:** Barn Center at Bethel Horizons Retreat Center, Dodgeville, WI

**SCHEDULE:** Please try to arrive by 12:30pm to check-in, drop off your dish to share and park your car. We will begin at 1:00pm, First with a talking circle of sharing, then Creating sacred space, followed by a guided meditation. I will then share some teachings and history about the grief ritual, instructions and then we will begin the ceremony. This Ceremony has a natural rhythm. It will end when it ends...when quiet has taken over the space and our hearts. We will complete with some processing (if necessary).

**5:00pm. POT LUCK-**Put out food. I will provide 2 hot stews, one vegan, one meat, both gluten free. I will also provide coffee & Tea for our gathering. I am asking people to bring a dish to share in these categories: Appetizer/snack, Salad, Dessert/sweet. We will have a commercial kitchen at our disposal with refrigerators, freezers, dish machine, dishes and serving utensils. I will ask for everyone to pitch in for clean-up. I expect we will be done by around 6:30pm. We will start a fire after dinner in the meeting room for those who wish to linger. There is an option to stay overnight for the cost of lodging.

**COST:** \$50 per person. Limited to 20 people. Overnight stay on Saturday add \$35 per person.
